## ABOUT THE DEMONSTRATOR

**Steve Sinner** resides in Bettendorf, Iowa and is a well known wood artist whose work is shown in prominent galleries and museums from New York to California such as the del Mano Gallery in California, the Nina Bliese Gallery in Minneapolis, MN and the Museum of Arts and Design in New York. Additionally, his work has been exhibited in a prestigious South Korean International Arts and Crafts competition three times and was awarded a special citation in 2003.

Steve graduated with a degree in Industrial Education from Iowa State University in 1965. Following graduation, Steve worked 32 years in industry and facilities management with woodworking among his hobbies. His passionate interest in woodturning as an art form was sparked in 1975 when he read Dale Nish's book "Creative Woodturning". Steve resigned from his "day job" in 1997 to become a full time turning artist. His primary turning interest is large vase forms, often embellished with innovative surface treatments.

In addition to his woodworking career, Steve plays the bass clarinet in two concert bands and has been a volunteer firefighter for nearly 30 years.
