

### Refrigerator Pickles



7 cups of cucumbers, sliced thin, but NOT peeled.

1 green pepper, diced  
1 large onion, diced  
1 cup white vinegar  
2 cups sugar  
1 Tablespoon salt  
1 teaspoon celery salt

Mix all ingredients together, adding cucumbers last, and pack in jars. Add rest of juice to jars. Be sure to press cucumbers down in jars.

These will keep 3-4 weeks in the refrigerator.

This will make approx 4 pint jars.
