Here's a recipe from club member Marj Pepin. If you have ever made a Bisquick Impossible pie, it is like that. It sounds good to me.



IMPOSSIBLE GREEN BEAN PIE

8 oz. fresh or frozen green beans
4 oz can of mushrooms
1/4 cup chopped onion
2 cloves garlic crushed (optional)
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1 1/2 cups milk
3/4 cup Bisquick
3 eggs
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Lightly grease pie plate.
Heat beans until tender (drain if any water).
Mix green beans, mushrooms, onion, garlic and cheese in pie plate.
In a separate bowl, beat remaining ingredients.
Pour into pie plate.
Bake 30-35 minutes until knife comes out clean.
Let stand 5 minutes before cutting.
