They know that Hans Christian Andersen made some in 1860. They have lots of other complicated designs too, and some are in the National Museum of Denmark in Copenhagen. They are a versatile item that can be used for Valentine's Day, Mother's Day, May Day, and even for Christmas. They can be made of felt or paper. BBQ Beef Biscuits

9x13 pan

2 rolls large size refrigerator biscuits

1# ground beef

BBQ sauce

2 cups shredded cheese

Smooch one package of biscuits to make bottom layer in pan, also going up the sides.

Bake at temp on label, until partially done. If you don't do this, it will be too soggy when all is done.

In the meantime, brown hamburger and add BBQ sauce.

Spread meat mixture onto biscuit layer and add 2 cups shredded cheese.

Cover with another layer of biscuits and bake about 30 minutes at same temperature.

Cut into squares and serve. Also, leftovers reheat very nicely.

Would also be good with BBQ pork, or maybe spaghetti, sauce and cheese. Many possibilities.
