Skull caps--These are very much needed for the pilots wearing NVG helmets for hours at a time. They have to be a very specific type, though. They have to fit very snugly and made with the right kind of material and reverse stitching. Otherwise, the seams themselves would cause hot spots. I am looking into our supply system today to see if they can send some over. Don't send them yet. But this was a good idea and I was surprised to see it on the list that you provided.

A lot of the items on the list can be purchased by the individuals, so I just put down the items I think they will be using the most.

Magazines, cards, sunscreen, Snacks, paper back books, Small throw rugs, small bottles of Hand sanitizer (this is being used a lot because of smallpox vaccinations), moisturizing eye drops, saline nasal spray, disposable cameras, stationary, pens/ clean joke books, beef jerky, plastic shoe box to keep their food stuff in, cookies (sealed good), shoestring potatoes/Pringles
