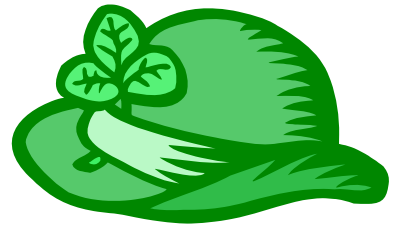

BAILEY'S IRISH CREAM CAKE

1 Pkg. yellow cake mix
4 oz. Instant chocolate pudding
3/4 C. Oil
1/8 C. Water
1/4 C. Vodka
3/8 C. Bailey's Irish Cream
4 Eggs



Combine cake mix, pudding mix, oil, water, vodka, liqueur and eggs in a bowl. Beat until smooth. Pour into greased and floured 10 inch Bundt pan. Bake at 350 degrees F 40 to 50 minutes or until done. Remove from pan and cool completely. Mix a glaze of Bailey's and powdered sugar to a thick consistency and drizzle over cake.
