I tried out this cookie recipe for a bake sale recently. They have just the right balance of everything and they are terrific! The name is very fitting.

Killer Cookies

Mix and set aside:

- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp salt

Beat until fluffy:

- 1 cup shortening
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup brown sugar

2 eggs - add one at a time
Then add 1 tsp vanilla

Add flour mixture.

Then add:

- 2 cups old fashioned oats
- 2 cups Rice Krispies
- 1 cup sweet flake coconut
- 6 ounces chocolate chips

Form balls of dough and bake @350 for 10 minutes.
Cool on pan for 5 minutes.

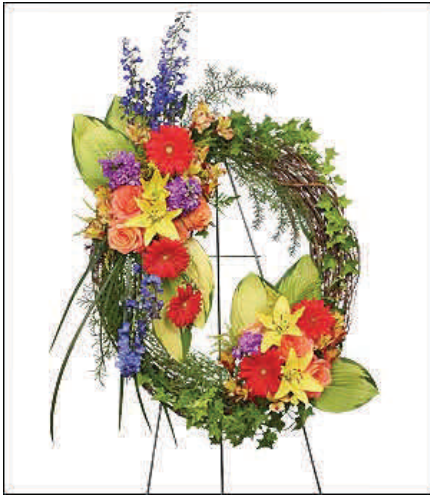
